



METHODOLOGY of admission to studies of foreign students for the 2025-2026 academic year

I. General framework

Art. 1. Admission to studies of foreign students at “Ion Ionescu de la Brad” University of Life Sciences Iași is done in accordance with:

- the Law Education no. 199/2023;
- Order No. 5508/2024 for the approval of the Methodology for the recognition and equivalence of short-term university, bachelor's, master's or postgraduate studies issued by accredited higher education institutions abroad;
- Order no. 4620/2024 on the approval of the Methodology for the recognition and equivalence of pre-university level studies obtained abroad and at education providers that provide pre-university education activities based on a curriculum of another state, on the territory of Romania;
- Order no. 3693/2024 for the approval of the Framework Methodology on the organization of admission to higher education in short-term university study cycles, bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees;
- Order no. 5552/2024 for the approval of the Methodology on the conditions of schooling of Romanians abroad and foreign citizens within accredited state, private and private confessional higher education institutions in Romania;
- Order no. 5655/2024 for the approval of the Methodology regarding the admission to studies of foreign citizens in university study cycles and in postgraduate education, on study places with the payment of tuition fees in foreign currency.;
- Order no. 6.786/2024 for the completion of the annex to the Order of the Minister of Education no. 5.552/2024 regarding the approval of the Methodology regarding the schooling conditions of Romanians from all over the world and foreign citizens within accredited state, private and private confessional higher education institutions in Romania;
- Order no. 5553/2024 regarding the approval of the Procedure for issuing letters of acceptance to studies of Romanians from all over the world for accredited state and private higher education, on study places with tuition fees in Ron.

Art. 2. Foreign candidates may be either citizens of a EU member state / of the European Economic Area/of the Swiss Confederation (EU/EEA/SC), or citizens of EU/EEA/SC third countries.

Art. 3. Candidates who are Romanian citizens and have received diplomas for studies abroad will apply for admission to studies in accordance with the regulations applicable for Romanian citizens, after obtaining the Certificate for Studies Recognition from CNRED (National Centre for Recognition and Equivalence of Diplomas).

Art. 4. Ethnic Romanian candidates from the Diaspora apply for admission in accordance with the Methodology of Order No. 5552/2024.

Art. 5. Foreign candidates are eligible to apply for the admission to university studies at “Ion Ionescu de la Brad” Iasi University of Life Sciences if:

(1) they hold the required diploma recognized by the competent authorities in their country of origin and by the Romanian authorities:

- **for admission to undergraduate (BA) studies** (1st Bologna cycle): Baccalaureate diploma;
- **for admission to graduate (MA) studies** (2nd Bologna cycle): Bachelor's degree diploma;
- **for admission to postgraduate (PhD) studies** (3rd Bologna cycle):

- Bachelor's degree and Master's degree (exclusively for candidates who've completed the 2nd Bologna cycle - MA studies);

- Bachelor's degree (for candidates who've graduated from BA medical studies of 6 years or candidates who've completed BA studies in extended form, the one existing before the implementation of the Bologna process – 5 years for engineering studies, 4 years for fundamental sciences and the field of humanities).

(2) they have the language skills required by the degree program for which they apply:

- Certificate or Attestation of language proficiency: minimum **B2 level Romanian language**; minimum **B1 level English language**;

- they are native speakers of that language or they are citizens of a country where the language of the degree program is an official language;

- they have studied at least 4 years in a program for which the language of teaching was the same as the language of the degree program for which they apply.

(3) they submit the application file within the deadline set by this methodology and participate and successfully pass the selection interview.

Art. 6. (1) In the case in which the candidates' study documents **do not meet the requirements of the Ministry of Education** (e.g. the minimum number of subjects relevant for the field of study they apply to, the average grade of the graduation exam, etc.), the International Relations Office will send the candidates a message, after consulting with the team of advisors from the Ministry of National Education, the management board of the Faculty they wish to enroll at, as well as with the University Admission Committee, concerning the decision taken in regards to receiving or rejecting the application file.

(2) Only after the Ministry of National Education evaluates the file and issues the Letter of acceptance to studies, the candidates may be enrolled at the University.

Art. 7. The admission contest will be organized in the month of **July 2025**. If there will be any number of places left vacant, there will be a **second admission session** organized in the month of **September 2025**.

Art. 8. The admission contest for the **2025-2026** academic year, **for the BA study programs, taught in Romanian**, from the domains of study of Agronomy, Horticulture, Engineering and Management in Agriculture and Rural Development, Food Engineering, Landscape architecture, Animal Sciences, Veterinary Medicine and Biology, in the **July 2025** session, will be organized during the **09 and 22 of July 2025** period, and for the **September 2025** session, during the **03 and 05 of September 2025** period.

Art. 9. The admission of candidates for study programs from the domains of study of Agronomy, Horticulture, Engineering and Management in Agriculture and Rural Development, Food Engineering, Landscape architecture, Animal Sciences, Biology and Veterinary Medicine in Romanian will be done through an admission contest based on the grade obtained at the Baccalaureate exam (N1): **100 %**.

Art. 10. The admission of the foreign candidates to the **Master study programs, for all domains/specializations of study, taught in Romanian** will be done based on a contest, following the criteria below:

a. an interview held at the University's headquarters or on-line, with the **“admitted”** or **“rejected”** results, during the **23 and 30 of June 2025**, respectively the **03-05 of September 2025**;

b. the results obtained in the final bachelor's exam.

c. Candidates can register online or at the faculty headquarters between **July 1 and 4, 2025**, and for possible September admission: **September 03 and 05, 2025**.

Art. 11. (1) The admission for the **doctoral programs of studies taught in Romanian**, for the **2025-2026** academic year, will be organized according to the specific regulations established by the Council for University Doctoral Studies and approved by the Institution that Organizes University Doctoral Studies.

(2) The registration of candidates is done online or at the faculties' headquarters between **June 16 and July 04, 2025**, and for the possible September admission: **September 03 and 10, 2025**.

II. Admission of candidates who are citizens of European Union / the European Economic Area / the Swiss Confederation member states (EU/EEA/SC)

Art. 12. The admission of candidates who are citizens of EU/EEA/SC member states to study at “Ion Ionescu de la Brad” University of Life Sciences Iași, in all fields of study, is done through an admission contest, according to this Methodology and to the Methodology of admission for Romanian citizens, based upon the available number of places offered on the basis of tuition.

Art. 13. (1) The admission contest for the 2025-2026 academic year, for the **Veterinary Medicine program of study taught in English**, at the **Faculty of Veterinary Medicine**, for the BA studies, is organized in the **July 09-22, 2025** period.

(2) The admission contest entails the 4 following steps:

a. sending the admission file, via electronic mail (between **April 28 and July 08, 2025**); the scanned documents will be sent to vet-admission@iuls.ro;

b. participating in an online interview with the admission committee (between **09 – 22 of July 2025** for undergraduate (BA) studies.

c. publication of preliminary admission results. The criteria for establishing the hierarchy among candidates are the following:

- the average obtained at the Baccalaureate exam – for the candidates applying for undergraduate (BA) studies 70% and the online interview 30%;

- the average obtained at the Bachelor’s degree final exam, at the Master’s degree final exam and the result obtained at the admission colloquium to postgraduate studies – for the candidates applying for postgraduate (PhD) studies.

d. publication of final admission results – July 22, 2025.

Art. 14. (1) To verify eligibility, candidates may send, any time between **April 28 and July 08, 2025**, in virtual form, scanned copies of the documents, on the e-mail address of the International Relations Office at: vet-admission@iuls.ro.

(2) All the documents from the admission file must either be originally written in Romanian, English or French, or they must be legalized copies translated into one of these languages.

(3) The International Relations Office will give candidates feedback concerning the eligibility of candidates or will request additional documents from the candidates.

Art. 15. (1) For the physical admission file, candidates from EU/EEA/EC countries will need to include certified copies of the documents necessary for the recognition of study documents by the National Center for the Recognition and Equivalence of Diplomas (CNRED) or the certificate/attestation of recognition issued by CNRED (for candidates who have already obtained this document).

(2) In order to have their diplomas recognized by the CNRED, candidates will be send to IULS their file containing the documents necessary for the recognition of their studies, until the **July 08, 2025**, so that it could be forwarded to CNRED.

Art. 16. The admission file.

(1) All the documents from the admission file must be written **in original** in Romanian, English or French, or be legalized translations of the originals in one of these languages.

(2) The admission file for the university must contain the following documents:

a. Application form for recognition of studies by CNRED together with the proof of payment addressed to the CNRED or the Recognition certificate already issued by the CNRED (Annex 1 to this methodology or available online on the university website <http://www.iuls.ro/admission/download.php>);

b. Application form for admission to studies at IULS Iași, written in Romanian or English, all requested information filled in (available online on the university’s website: <http://www.iuls.ro/admission/download.php>).

c. Diplomas or Certificates of graduation for graduates of 2025, as applicable:

- for admission to undergraduate (BA) studies (1st Bologna cycle): **Baccalaureate diploma** or a **certificate of graduation**, that replaces the diploma, for students who graduate in the summer 2025.

- for admission to graduate (MA) studies (2nd Bologna cycle): **Bachelor's degree**;

- for admission to postgraduate (PhD) studies (3rd Bologna cycle):

- **Bachelor's degree and Master's degree** (exclusively for candidates who've completed the 2nd Bologna cycle - MA studies) and

- **Bachelor's degree** (for candidates who've graduated from BA medical studies of 6 years or candidates who've completed BA studies in extended form, the one existing before the implementation of the Bologna process – 5 years for engineering studies, 4 years for fundamental sciences and the field of humanities).

d. **Proof of completion (transcript of records)** of high school, with subjects and marks/points obtained, for the diplomas mentioned at **point c** - copy, if the study document is issued in Romanian, English, French language; copy and certified translation (in original) in Romanian language for the documents issued in other languages.

e. **Birth certificate**.

f. **Passport** – legible copies of 1st to 4th page from the passport, which specify information about the person and contain a photo – **or any other national document of identity which is recognized on EU territory**.

g. **Medical certificate issued** in an international language (English, French) to prove that the person registered for studies does not suffer from spreading diseases or other illnesses that are incompatible with the future profession. The University reserves the right to further request the opinion of a specialized medical commission (Occupational Medicine) to check candidates with chronic diseases/disabilities);

h. **Marriage certificate**, or any other document which certifies the change of name, if applicable.

i. **Language Certificate or proof of having completed at least 4 consecutive years of studies in the language of instruction of the program of studies for which the candidate applies**. Candidates that do not provide a Language Certificate which assesses at least Speaking, Writing and Listening skills (B1) will add the proof of payment of 50 euro for the English evaluation test (taken with IULS Foreign Languages Department). If the candidates are native speakers of that language or they come from a country where the language of instruction of the program of studies at the University (IULS Iași) is recognized as an official language, the language certificate is not necessary. The candidates who choose studies with Romanian as language of instruction but cannot provide these certifying documents, will have to enroll in a preparatory year for studying Romanian, therefore they will be considered as ineligible for the current session of admission contest. The preparatory year for studying Romanian, as well as taking the language exam, are organized at one of the universities mentioned in Annex 3.

j. **Proof of payment for file evaluation fee – 100 euro**

k. **4 photos passport size**

l. List of publications and curriculum vitae – only for PhD candidates.

Art. 17. The International Relations Office, in charge of the admission of foreign students, will post on the university's site additional documents regarding the certifying conditions for each type of document needed and for each type of candidates (legalized translations, documents containing the Hague Apostille, documents needing certification from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the candidate's country of origin and from Romania's Consulate, etc.), as well as special mentions regarding documents needed (medical certificate), in accordance with the respective methodologies issued by the Ministry of National Education.

Art. 18. (1) The admission file must be sent to the USV Iași Registry, Aleea Mihail Sadoveanu, no. 3, code 700490, Iași, ROMANIA, with the mention: "for the admission committee - admission of foreign citizens". Deadline for receipt: **July 08, 2025**.

(2) Candidates must also send to USV Iași the file with documents in legalized copies for CNRED for the equivalence procedures of study documents. Deadline for receipt: **July 8, 2025**.

Art. 19. The International Relations Office will send each candidate a confirmation message regarding the arrival of the file, its degree of completeness or what documents are missing and the deadline before which these must be sent.

Art. 20. After having checked the eligibility of the file, received an answer from the University and obtained the Certificate of Recognition of diplomas from CNRED or after sending the documents required for the recognition of studies by CNRED, candidates coming from EU/EEA/SC member states will be scheduled for an online interview with the Admission Committee between 09th – 22nd of July 2025. For candidates for **Veterinary Medicine - English language study program**, the original documents are brought at the beginning of the academic year, as soon as the students arrive in Iași.

Art. 21. Besides having to submit the complete file, candidates applying for postgraduate (PhD) studies will have to take part in the admission colloquium to postgraduate studies, together with the rest of the candidates, Romanian or international citizens, within the deadline set and in accordance with the methodology of organizing that specific admission examination.

Art. 22. (1) The criteria for differentiating between candidates and establishing the hierarchy are the following:

- the average obtained at the Baccalaureate exam – for the candidates applying for undergraduate (BA) studies in Romanian; for **Veterinary Medicine in English**, the admission average calculated as: the average obtained at the Baccalaureate exam (70%) and the grade obtained at the selection interview (30%);

- the average obtained at the Bachelor's Degree final exam – for the candidates applying for graduate (MA) studies;

- the average obtained at the Bachelor's degree final exam, at the Master's degree final exam and the result obtained at the admission colloquium to postgraduate studies – for the candidates applying for postgraduate (PhD) studies.

(2) The admission to studies is done by taking into account the decreasing order of average grades obtained by candidates at their Baccalaureate exam and the number of places available for the admission.

For Veterinary Medicine in English, the admission to studies is done by taking into account the decreasing order of the admission average grades calculated as: the average obtained at the Baccalaureate exam (70%) and the grade obtained at the selection interview (30%), and the number of places available for the admission.

(3) The admission committee established for each Faculty will make the conversion of the candidates' grades to the Romanian grading system (grades from 1 to 10).

(4) In the case in which there are more candidates with the same average grade at the Baccalaureate exam, the criterion for differentiating between them will be the average grade of their 3 / 4 / 5 years of high school studies.

Art. 23. (1) The Faculties will send to the Rectorate's Secretariat and to the International Relations Office:

- the list of candidates nominated for obtaining the Certificate of Recognition of studies from the National Centre for Recognition and Equivalence of Diplomas (CNRED), along with the candidates' files, created in accordance with Article 16 from this methodology;

- the list of candidates who may be conditionally admitted (for these candidates, the Certificate of Recognition of studies from CNRED will be requested after the requirements have been met);

- the list of rejected candidates.

Art. 24. The International Relations Office will send each candidate a message regarding their situation. The results of the admission contest will also be posted on the University's website.

Art. 25. Within 5 calendar days from uploading the results, the candidates coming from EU/EEA/SC member states who have been admitted to studies at "Ion Ionescu de la Brad" Iasi University of Life Sciences must download the Learning Agreement, sign it, scan and return to the secretariats of the faculties they have enrolled in, in electronic format, and will pay the tuition fee by bank transfer to the university account.

Candidates declared admitted to the Veterinary Medicine – English language study program will pay a first installment of 1500 EUR related to the tuition fee within 5 calendar days from the display of the results. This also constitutes a guarantee in case of withdrawal of the candidate and is not refunded in this case. The other two installments related to the tuition fee (each in the amount of 2000 EUR) are paid in the first week of the first semester, respectively before the start of the first (winter) exam session.

III. Admission of candidates who are *not* citizens of European Union / the European Economic Area / the Swiss Confederation member states (*non-EU/EEA/SC*)

Art. 26. The admission contest will be organized in the month of **July 2025**. If there will be any number of places left vacant, there will be a second admission session organized in the month of **September 2025**.

Art. 27. The admission of candidates who are citizens of non-EU/EEA/SC member states to study at “Ion Ionescu de la Brad” Iasi University Life Sciences, in all fields of study, is done through an admission contest, according to this Methodology of admission, based upon the available number of places offered on the basis of tuition.

Art. 28. (1) The admission contest for the 2025-2026 academic year, for the **Veterinary Medicine program of study taught in English**, at the **Faculty of Veterinary Medicine**, for the BA studies, is organized between **July 09 - 22, 2025**.

(2) The admission contest entails the following steps:

a. sending the admission file, in virtual format via e-mail (April 28 - July 8, 2025);
b. forwarding to ME – DGRIAE (the Ministry of Education - General Department for International Relations and European Affairs), from the University, the Agreement-in-principle and the list of non-EU/EEA/SC candidates proposed for receiving the Letter of Acceptance to studies in Romania;

c. receiving at the University, from the Ministry of Education (ME), the Letter of Acceptance to studies in Romania for the non-EU/EEA/SC candidates and informing the candidates who were declared eligible to apply for the admission contest;

d. Publication of the admission results. The criteria for establishing the hierarchy among candidates are the following:

- the average obtained at the Baccalaureate exam – for the candidates applying for undergraduate (BA) studies 70% and the online interview 30%.

- the average obtained at the Bachelor’s Degree final exam – for the candidates applying for graduate (MA) studies;

- the average obtained at the Bachelor’s degree final exam, at the Master’s degree final exam and the result obtained at the admission colloquium to postgraduate studies – for the candidates applying for postgraduate (PhD) studies.

Art. 29. (1) To verify eligibility, candidates may send, any time between **April 28 and July 08, 2025**, in virtual form, scanned copies of the documents, on the e-mail address of the International Relations Office at: vet-admission@iuls.ro.

(2) All documents in the admission file must either be originally written in Romanian, English or French, or must be translated in Romanian, and legalized copies of the original documents.

(3) The admissions committee will decide on the candidate's eligibility or will request that the candidate complete the application form, so that he or she can prepare the admissions file in physical format.

Art. 30. The admission file.

(1) All the documents from the admission file must be written **in original in Romanian, English or French, or be legalized translations** of the originals in one of these languages.

(2) The registration file will contain the following documents in legalized copies:

a. **Application form for the issuance** of the Letter of Acceptance for Studies by the Ministry of Education (Annex 2 to this methodology or available online on the university website: <http://www.iuls.ro/admission/download.php>).

b. **Application form for admission** to USV Iași in Romanian or English, completed in all sections and with a photo (available online on the university website: <http://www.iuls.ro/admission/download.php>).

c. **Diplomas of graduation:**

- for admission to studies undergraduate (BA) studies (1st Bologna cycle): Baccalaureate diploma, or a **certificate of graduation**, that replaces the diploma, *for students who graduate in the summer of 2025*;

- for admission to graduate (MA) studies (2nd Bologna cycle): Bachelor's degree;

- for admission to doctoral studies (3rd Bologna): bachelor's and master's degrees (exclusively for candidates coming from the 2nd Bologna cycle -master's degree) and bachelor's degree (candidates who graduated from 6-year bachelor's medical studies or candidates who completed long-form bachelor's studies, existing before the implementation of the Bologna system - 5 years for engineering tracks, 4 years for fundamental sciences and humanities).

d. **Transcript of Records/diploma Supplement**, for the diplomas mentioned at **point c.**

e. **Birth certificate.**

f. **Passport** – legible copies of 1st to 4 page from the passport, which specify information about the person and contain a photo. At the date on which the Letter of Acceptance to studies is issued, the passport must be valid for at least another 6 months.

g. **Document specifying the permanent residence abroad** in the home country (issued by a local authority)

h. **Medical certificate** issued in an international language (English, French) to prove that the person registered for studies does not suffer from spreading diseases or other illnesses that are incompatible with the future profession. The University reserves the right to further request the opinion of a specialized medical commission (Occupational Medicine) to check candidates with chronic diseases/disabilities

i. **Marriage certificate**, or any other document which certifies the change of name, if applicable.

j. **Language Certificate or proof of having completed at least 4 consecutive years of studies in the language of instruction of the program of studies for which the candidate applies.** Candidates that do not provide a Language Certificate which assesses at least Speaking, Writing and Listening skills (B1) will add the proof of payment of 50 euro for the English evaluation test (taken with IULS Foreign Languages Department). If the candidates are native speakers of that language or they come from a country where the language of instruction of the program of studies at the University (IULS Iași) is recognized as an official language, the language certificate is not necessary. The candidates who choose studies with Romanian as language of instruction but cannot provide these certifying documents, will have to enroll in a preparatory year for studying Romanian, therefore they will be considered as ineligible for the current session of admission contest. The preparatory year for studying Romanian, as well as taking the language exam, are organized at one of the universities mentioned in Annex 3.

m. **PET results (only for candidates from Israel)**

n. **A list of publications and a Curriculum Vitae** – only for candidates applying for postgraduate (PhD) studies.

Art.31. The International Relations Office, in charge of the admission of foreign students, will post on the university's site additional documents regarding the certifying conditions for each type of document needed and for each category of candidates (legalized translations, documents bearing the Hague Apostille, documents needing certification from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the candidate's country of origin and from Romania's Consulate, etc.), as well as special mentions regarding documents needed (medical certificate), in accordance with the respective methodologies issued by the Ministry of National Education and Scientific Research.

Art. 32. (1) The files for USV Iași must be sent to the Registry of the University for Life Sciences of Iași, Aleea Mihail Sadoveanu, no. 3, code 700490, Iași, ROMANIA, with the

mention: "for the Admissions Committee - admission of foreign citizens". Deadline: **July 08, 2025**.

Art. 33. The International Relations Office will send each candidate a confirmation message regarding the arrival of the file, its degree of completeness or what documents are missing and the deadline before which these must be sent.

Art. 34. **After having checked the eligibility of the file, having received an answer from the University regarding the Agreement-in-principle and only after having obtained the Letter of Acceptance to studies in Romania, issued by the Ministry of Education,** the International Relations Office will forward the files to the admission committees of each Faculty, so that all admission criteria specific to each Faculty / program of studies and also the capacity of accredited schooling may be evaluated.

Art. 35. The faculties will communicate to the Rectorate Secretariat and the Admissions Committee:

- the list of candidates nominated for obtaining the Letter of Acceptance to studies from the Ministry of Education, along with the candidates' files, organized in accordance with Article 30 from this methodology;
- the list of candidates who may be conditionally admitted (for them, the Letter of Acceptance to studies will be requested after pon the conditions);
- the list of rejected candidates.

Art. 36. Besides having to submit the complete file, candidates applying for postgraduate (PhD) studies will have to take part in the admission colloquium to postgraduate studies, together with the rest of the candidates, Romanian or international citizens, within the deadline set and in accordance with the methodology of organizing that specific admission examination.

Art. 37. The criteria for differentiating between candidates and establishing the hierarchy are the following:

- the average obtained at the Bacalaureate exam – for the candidates applying for undergraduate (BA) studies in Romanian; for Veterinary Medicine in English, the admission average calculated as: the average obtained at the Bacalaureate exam (70%) and the grade obtained at the selection interview (30%);
- the average obtained at the Bachelor's Degree final exam – for the candidates applying for graduate (MA) studies;
- the average obtained at the Bachelor's degree final exam, at the Master's degree final exam and the result obtained at the admission colloquium to postgraduate studies – for the candidates applying for postgraduate (PhD) studies.

(2) The admission to studies is done by taking into account the decreasing order of average grades obtained by candidates at their Bacalaureate exam and the number of places available for the admission. For Veterinary Medicine in English, the admission to studies is done by taking into account the decreasing order of the admission average grades calculated as: the average obtained at the Bacalaureate exam (70%) and the grade obtained at the selection interview (30%), and the number of places available for the admission.

(3) The admission committee established for each Faculty will make the conversion of the candidates' grades to the Romanian grading system (grades from 1 to 10).

(4) In the case in which there are more candidates with the same average grade at the Bacalaureate exam, the criterion for differentiating between them will be the average grade of their 3 / 4 years of high school studies.

Art. 38. The admission committee will send each candidate a message regarding their situation. The results of the admission contest will also be posted on the University's site.

Art. 39. **Within 5 calendar days from uploading the results,** the candidates coming from non – EU/EEA/SC member states who have been admitted to studies at "Ion Ionescu de la Brad" **Iasi** University of Life Sciences must download the Learning Agreement, sign it, scan it and send it in electronic format to the Secretariat of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine along **with the proof of a payment of 5500 EUR representing the tuition fee for the first year of study through bank transfer to the University's bank account. From this amount 1500 EUR represents a guarantee in case of latter renouncement to be enrolled as student to our**

university and will not be refunded. In case the visa for studies is not granted by the diplomatic mission of Romania from the candidate's country of origin, the equivalent value of the paid tuition fee will be returned to the candidate, except for the bank commissions and fees which are involved in this transaction.

III. Registration procedures of foreign candidates

Art.40. Candidates who are citizens of EU/EEA/SC member states and have been admitted to study at "Ion Ionescu de la Brad" Iasi University Life Sciences, will be registered after signing and returning the Learning Agreement to their respective Faculties' Secretariats and after paying the first amount of the tuition fee for the first year of study.

Art.41. Candidates who are citizens of non – EU/EEA/SC member states and have been admitted to study at "Ion Ionescu de la Brad" Iasi University Life Sciences, will be registered after signing and returning the Learning Agreement to their respective Faculties' Secretariats, after receiving the visa for studies and the residence permit for staying in Romania and after paying the tuition fee for the first year of study.

Art.42. (1) Upon registration, before at the beginning of the academic year, the admitted candidates will present at the Faculty Secretariat all the documents from the admission file in their original form and certified according to the regulations of the Ministry of Education.

(2) Admitted candidates who are citizens of EU/EEA/SC member states must submit the original study documents and, in duplicate, copies and certified translations (in original) in Romanian language for the admission file documents issued in other languages than Romanian, English or French.

(3) Admitted candidates who are citizens of non – EU/EEA/SC member states must submit the original study documents and one set of legalized copies and certified translation (in original) in Romanian language for the admission file documents.

(4) The Hague Apostille is requested for diplomas from countries which are parties to the Hague Apostille, issued by the competent authorities in the issuing countries. The Hague Apostille is requested for diplomas from Italy, Greece, Spain, Portugal and Cyprus;

(5) Diplomas issued in countries which are not parties to the Hague Apostille Convention shall be authenticated or accompanied by an authentication certificate from by the competent authorities in the issuing countries. (6) Failing to bring the original documents to the Secretariat (and, also, for non-EU candidates, receiving the visa for studies) until 30.09.2025 will lead to losing the place obtained in the admission contest.

Art. 43. The admitted candidates will sign a Learning Agreement with the University, which will be identical to the one signed and circulated in electronic format.

Art. 44. (1) The tuition fees for candidates who are citizens of EU/EEA/SC member states are the same as those established for the Romanian citizens and are approved by the University's Senate.

(2) **The tuition fees for candidates who are citizens of EU/EEA/SC and third countries (non – EU/EEA/SC member states)** and have been admitted to studies on the basis of **self-funding (at their own expense)**, are approved by the University's Senate, in accordance with Government Ordinance no. 22/29.08.2009, as follows, Table 1:

Art.45. The candidates who have been admitted to study at “Ion Ionescu de la Brad” University of Life Sciences and Veterinary Medicine of Iași will ask at the diplomatic mission of Romania from their respective countries of origin information about the conditions of obtaining the visa for studies and the residence permit for staying in Romania.

IV. Final provisions

Art.46. In the case in which special situations arise, which are not covered by the regulations of this Methodology, these will be reported to the University Admission Committee, which is the only one authorized to manage these particular issues.

Art.47. The Senate of “Ion Ionescu de la Brad” University of Life Sciences Iași grants the Management Board the right to complete the present Methodology with subsequent provisions issued by the Ministry of Education. These provisions will be brought forward to the members of the Senate during the immediately next meeting.

Art.48. In the case in which any provisions of this Methodology are not consistent with the regulations of the Ministry, the ones which will be implemented will be the ones issued by the Ministry of Education.

This Methodology was approved in the Senate meeting on 19th of **December 2024**.

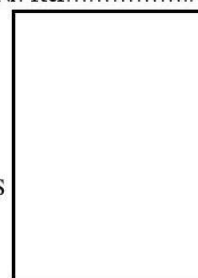
