GUIDE TO ERASMUS STUDENTS

Pre-arrival information

After registering and submitting in the online Application Form, students must complete the online Learning Agreement (https://www.erasmus-dashboard.eu/intro). The Learning Agreement must be approved by the Erasmus Delegates of both the Sending Institution and the "G. d'Annunzio" University of Chieti-Pescara (https://www.unich.it/didattica/studiare-allestero/docenti-delegati).

The Learning Agreement must be signed by the student and the Delegates of both universities, and it must include the official stamps of both institutions. A copy of the Learning Agreement must be emailed to incoming@unich.it before the student's arrival.

Enrolment

Upon arrival students are requested to enrol at the Erasmus Office located on the campus of Chieti (<u>Via dei Vestini 31, in Chieti</u>; phone +39 0871 3554802; email: <u>incoming@unich.it</u>). The Erasmus Office is open from 10:00-12:00 Monday to Friday. Students must have the following documents with them:

- Application Form duly completed and signed;
- a valid identity document;
- 2 passport-size pictures;

PLEASE NOTE:

- Students enrolled at the Departments of Architecture, Economics, Economics and Management, Engineering, Languages and Modern Culture, Philosophical, Legal and Social Sciences (Economics area) and Social Sciences, Economics and Quantitative Methods (Economics area), will attend lessons at the campus of Pescara, located in Viale Pindaro 42, in Pescara.
- Students enrolled at the Departments of Pharmacy, Geology, Humanities and Social Sciences, Medicine and Ageing Sciences, Neurosciences and Imaging, Legal and Social Sciences (Social area), Social Sciences, Economics and Quantitative Methods (Social area), Oral and Biotechnological Medicine, Psychological, Humanistic and Territorial Sciences, will attend lessons at the campus of Chieti, located in Via dei Vestini 31, in Chieti.

At the end of the enrolment procedure students will receive:

- Arrival Certificate
- Exams booklet
- A form stating stating their status as Incoming Erasmus Students. This form will also enable students to get their own card to access the canteen. Students can request their canteen card at the Adsu premises in Chieti, <u>Viale della Unità D'Italia</u>, 32/A, 66100 Chieti (opening times: Monday to Friday 9:30 a.m. -12:00 p.m.; Tuesday and Thursday 3.00 p.m. 4:30 p.m.).

During the stay

The Italian language courses for incoming Erasmus students will start at the beginning of each semester (mid-September and mid-February). The courses will be taught at the University Language Centre (Centro Linguistico di Ateneo) located in Pescara.

Changes to the Learning Agreement have to be agreed upon by the Erasmus Delegates of the Sending and the Receiving Universities. The new learning agreement must be emailed to the Erasmus Office at incoming@unich.it.

Students who wish to extend the length of their Erasmus programme must be authorised by both the Sending and the Receiving Universities. The authorisation must be emailed to the Erasmus Office at incoming@unich.it

Before departure

Students who have completed their study programme at the University of Chieti-Pescara are required to visit the Erasmus Office located on their campus (Chieti or Pescara) before departure in order to debrief and collect their:

- final Transcript of Records
- Certificate of Attendance

How to reach the Pescara railway station from Pescara Airport

From PESCARA airport to Pescara train station, take bus nr. 8, which departs every 20 minutes. (Timetable: https://moovitapp.com/index/en/public transit-line-8-Pescara ed Abruzzo-3762-858496-402584-0); alternatively, you can take bus nr. 38, which departs every 20 minutes and get off at the stop located in Corso Vittorio Emanuele II or any other stop close to the railway station

How to reach the Pescara Campus from Pescara terminal bus/train station

Take the TUA Bus number 7 (direction Pescara Terminal Bus -Valle Rocca) and get off at the bus stop located in Viale Pindaro, Pescara.

How to reach the Chieti Campus from Pescara terminal bus/train station


By bus:

By train:
