- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within six weeks after the application deadline.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than six weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. Please note that some delays may occur due to national holidays or winter / summer vacation.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

The agreement will become operative on the date of signature of both universities and shall remain in force the full duration of the ERASMUS+ Programme. In case of a prior termination, a written notice of at least one academic year should be sent to the partner university. Any additions and/or amendments should be agreed upon in writing at least one academic year before it will come into effect. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution upon the student's departure or, in any case, no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
- 4. Termination of the agreement
- [It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a

notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 2014 will only take effect as of 1 September 2014+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]
