

Between 5 and 23 August 2024 the Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programme "**Environmental Risk Camp - A perspective from bio/nanotechnologies and geo-engineering**" will take place at BOKU University, Vienna (Austria). A mix of lectures, group exercises, university visits and intercultural activities (4 ECTS, no course fees).

Contents:

- Concepts of risk and (emerging) risk technologies, ecological vulnerability, pathways to risk
- Introduction to biotechnology
- Introduction to nanotechnology and plastics
- Introduction to geo-engineering
- Prospective technology assessment
- Governance, policy and identified needs regarding the discussed technologies
- Concepts of environmental ethics

Target group:

Master level students from BOKU partner universities from Environmental Sciences, Biotechnology or related subjects who have finished at least 1 semester (30 ECTS) in their study program are welcome to apply. Depending on their academic background also Bachelor's and Doctoral students are encouraged to apply and can be accepted for the programme. Accepted applicants are highly encouraged to apply for an Erasmus+ funding for BIP mobilities at their home university.

The BIP programme is a joint initiative from BOKU University/Austria, Babeş-Bolyai University/Romania and Kaunas University of Technology/Lithuania. The virtual part of the programme takes place: maximum 1 day before the physical part, further information to be announced.
